What do you know about the Holy Week and Easter?

On Easter Sunday, Christians swphucsinh celebrate the <u>resurrection</u> of Jesus Christ on the third day khổ hình thập giá; sw đóng dinh after his <u>crucifixion</u>. It also marks the end of the 40-day sw sám hối - Mùa Chay period of <u>penance</u> called <u>4Lent</u>. Easter is considered to be the most important season of the Christian year.



Holy Week

Chúa Nhật Lễ Lá 5Palm Sunday

April 14, 2019 - For Christians, Palm Sunday commemorates Jesus' arrival in Jerusalem prior to his crucifixion, where palm leaves and clothing were laid in his path.

nghi thức Rước kiệu Palm Sunday is often celebrated with a ⁶procession and distribution of palm leaves.

In some churches, the palms are saved and burnt into ashes to be used on *thứ Tư Lễ Tro* 7<u>Ash Wednesday</u> of the next year.

Chúa Nhật Thương Khó Palm Sunday is also called ⁸Passion Sunday.

It is the last Sunday of Lent and first day of Holy Week.

Thứ Năm Tuần Thánh 9<u>Maundy Thursday</u>

April 18, 2019 - also called Holy Thursday.

- *Bữa Tiệc Ly* The observance commemorates the ¹⁰Last Supper, before Jesus' crucifixion.
- nghi thức rước lễ Some churches hold a special ¹¹communion service.

Thứ Sáu Tuần Thánh 12<u>Good Friday</u>

April 19, 2019 - For Christians, it is a day of mourning and penance. Good Friday marks the day Jesus died on the cross.

Good Friday is celebrated the Friday before Easter Sunday.

việc ăn chay Many observe the day by ¹³fasting and attending church services.

Lễ Chúa Thánh Thần hiện weeks, ending with ¹⁴<u>Pentecost</u>.

April 21, 2019 - Easter Sunday.

It is celebrated on the first Sunday after the first full moon following the first day of spring.

In some countries, Easter is called "Pascha", which comes from the $L\tilde{e}$ Vuot Qua Hebrew word for ¹⁵Passover.

Christianity is one of the world's largest religions, with approximately two billion followers around the world.

Symbols & Customs

Among the popular Easter symbols, the lamb is by far the most significant of this great feast.

Phục Sinh The blessing of the ¹⁶Paschal or Easter candle at the ¹⁷Easter Vigil and its sáp nến use throughout the year is rich in symbolism. The pure ¹⁸wax extracted by xác thịt bees from flowers symbolizes the pure ¹⁹flesh of Christ received from His bắc – ngọn lửa Virgin Mother, the ²⁰wick signifies the soul of Christ, and the ²⁰flame

thần tính represents His ²¹divinity.

Eggs have long been a symbol of life and rebirth.
